A LOCAL LAW TO ADD GENERAL REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING DOGS TO THE TOWN OF ROYALTON CODE

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Royalton as follows.

Section 1. The Royalton Town Code shall be amended to add the following definitions to the "running at large", section 50-3 (F).

§ 50-3 (F) Running at large. All dogs are to be restrained by a leash not exceeding 10 feet in length while off the owners premises whether or not tagged or licensed. Any person owning or harboring a dog shall not suffer or allow it to run at large in any of the streets are public places of this Town or upon the premises of anyone other than the owner or custodian unless the owner or occupant of such premises grants permission. The Dog Control Officer or any of his duly authorized assistants or the duly authorized agents of any person or corporation enforcing the provisions of the Agriculture and Markets Law and Public Health Law relating to dogs shall be empowered to seize any dog not so restrained found off of the owner's promises.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
