

GUIDELINES FOR THE TOWN OF ROYALTON HOMETOWN HEROES APPLIATION

All Servicemen or Servicewomen must have the following qualifications:

1. Reside within the Town of Royalton presently, or at some time in their lifetime.
2. Served or serving our country in one of the following branches of service: Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines or Navy.
3. Each servicemember/servicewoman must be presently serving, or be an honorably discharged veteran, MIA, or died in the line of duty.

Eras of Service: Official Department of Defense Dates (Please choose the one that fits the era of service and enter on the application form)

- Persian Gulf War / War on Terror: August 2, 1990 – Present (Afghanistan, Iraq)
- Conflicts in Panama, Grenada, Lebanon
- Viet Nam: August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975
- Korea: June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955
- WWII: December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946
- WWI: April 6, 1917 – November 11, 1918
- Civil War: April 12, 1861 – April 9, 1865
- Peacetime (Enter dates of service)

Banner Pricing

The cost of the banner and hardware is **\$200.00**. This will include a double-sided vinyl banner, appropriate hardware, and storage of the banner. **All orders with the payment are due no later than December 31st of each year.** The banners will be prepared for production in January and February by The Print Shop in Medina, NY, giving us time for inspection and editing, if necessary. Payment can be made by CASH or CHECK. The check should be made payable to the "Town of Royalton" with a name and Hometown Hero in the memo section of your check.

The banners will be hung from the utility poles throughout various sections of the town from Memorial Day through Labor Day of each year.

Banners will be displayed for a period of three (3) years and then retired to the families.

Photo for the Banner

You will supply the photo of the Veteran in uniform that you wish to appear on the banner. Pictures will be scanned and returned to you once the banner is approved. If possible, a large original photo will provide the best quality picture for the banner. **Please attach a self-addressed envelope to return the photo to you.** Also, please make sure to sign the photo release on the application so we can use the photo for publicity purposes, if necessary.

The banners will be hung up each year for a period of three (3) years and then returned to the family.

Sponsorship
